

GUIDED TOUR RULES

- Wrist bands must be worn and always displayed.
- No alcoholic beverages or drugs allowed
 - o If guests with driver's bands are seen drinking, they are expelled from the ride
- Only legally able drivers allowed to operate machines during park rides or tours
 - Minors must be accompanied and supply minor waiver form
 - Wrist bands checked
- All Safety Equipment for rider (Harness, eye protection at minimum, helmets required if under 18) and machine (Headlights, Taillights, Brakes, etc) must be in full operational condition.
- o Headlights must be on at all times
- If you get lost, park on the side of the trail on a highly visible straight section close by and stay put. We will come find you. DO NOT COME LOOKING FOR US. Text/Call guide or family immediately.
- No unapproved gas containers allowed in rear storage of vehicles during park rides or tours
- Obey all speed limit and warning signs
- Always ride to the extreme right side of the trail driving defensively
- All firearms (rifles, shotguns, and hand guns) are prohibited except for concealed hand guns with required Concealed Hand Gun License
- o Fireworks, BB guns, air rifles, and paint ball markers are not permitted
- No hunting
- No erratic driving (doughnuts, power-stands, etc) on road routes or parking lots or on trail in any unsigned scramble area
- All pets must be leashed
- No glass containers are allowed
- Do not harass any wildlife, yield to all wildlife
- Yield to all non-motorized traffic, shut machines off if equine encountered
- Pick up all trash and debris from your area upon leaving
- Park and ride only in designated areas
- Helmets must always be worn by ATV / motorcycle riders
- Dangerous operation of any vehicle will not be tolerated. Second warning from guide serves as voluntary expulsion from ride.
- Follow all trail markings of the trail system
- Do not ride off-trail
- Do not make new trails
- Respect the other riders and pass with caution
- Utilize hand signals for indicating riders behind you only if in a situation you can safely remove a hand from the steering wheel or handlebar. Do not risk your safety to perform this function.

Violation of these rules is grounds for removal from the park and or guided tour. Flagrant or continued violation of these rules is grounds for permanent expulsion from the park and revocation of guide agreement.
